2011 Member Survey

We would like to thank those who responded in this year's Member Survey – over 40% of our members participated. Highlights of the survey results include:

- ◆ 97.9% ranked EWHC programs as *Good* or *Excellent*, and 64% identified *Topic* as the primary reason they attend — 14% said the *Speaker* was the main motivation.
